This week we have continued the Three Little Pigs theme. The foundation children have sequenced pictures from the story and made their own booklets. The children have added certain numbers of muddy patches on pigs, played I Spy Little Pigs and recorded the number they could find and listened out for initials sounds and then constructed cvc words.

Using the book 'What would I do with a tail like this?' the Y1 children have used the sentence opening 'If I was ...' to describe what they would need if they were doing a specific activity and what they would need to wear if there were different types of weather. They have continued to consolidate their understanding of addition fact families using different ways of representing this and have worked on explaining the relationship between the numbers.

As you have probably heard we have been practising the Nativity with earnest as the weeks are quickly moving on. Thank you for working with the children to learn the words. It really does help.

Thank you to Reuben's mum for coming into school to help some of the children in the school make a Christmas scene for the Nativity Festival.
