Dear Parents

I hope this finds you all well and coping with the latest easing of lockdown?

As you are aware, the government published its guidance on returning to school for September on Thursday and we are beginning to work out exactly how this will be achieved at both schools. We are expecting a further document on Friday which should make it clearer for Devon schools.

This is a complicated procedure but the team and I are writing the new arrangements and risk assessments. These will come out to you in due course before the end of the term. However, I just felt you would like to know that we will be welcoming all the children back so you can make your plans and know at least that this is the intention.

Although there has been some easing of the restrictions we have to put in place such as the number in each 'bubble' of children, most of the protocols we have had in place since the beginning and those you will have read about from 1 June when more year groups joined us, will still need to be in place and rigorous.

As soon as we have all the plans 'signed off' I will let you know both by letter and they will be put on the web page as usual.
