

Don't forget that your writing needs to be able to be read by somebody else.


You need to...

# Maths: Frogs and Toads.

Today we are going to use our thinking skills to solve a problem.

There are 3 frogs and 3 toads, who share 7 lily-pads. They have a problem – they want to swap places so that the frogs are on the right and the toads are on the left.



To move they can either slide one space or hop over another frog or toad onto an empty lily-pad. They can't share a lily-pad and they can't move backwards. Use coins or buttons to represent the frogs and toads and see if you can get all the toads to where the frogs are and all the frogs on the right hand side.




# This week's Rainbow Challenges:
