

Poems can be written in lots of different ways and as we found out yesterday, we start to learn them when we are very little.


Today we are going to look at an acrostic poem. Look carefully at the poem by Philip Waddell – what do you notice about the first letter of each line?



## English: Poetry




# This week's Rainbow Challenges:
