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Watch the video through a second time. This time think about what is the same about this film and the film we saw last week. Tell your helper what you have noticed. What do you notice about how the Baboon is feeling?

What is different about the two films? How is the story different? Why was the Baboon on the moon?

In your books, can you write a sentence or two to say what is the same about the two films.

Now write one or two sentences to say how the films are different.

Don't forget to think about your sentence before you write. How many words are you going to write? Make sure you include finger spaces and use your sound mat and tricky words to help you.

Maths: Compare Numbers

I'm thinking of a number – see if you can guess what it is.

My number is one more than one ten and 3 ones.

It is also one less than 15.

What's my number?

My new number is one less than 20 and one more than 18. What's my number – one ten and _____ ones?

Can you recall these symbols?

An active idea: Mindfulness
