In the film, the little girl writes a letter to the man in the moon.
What do you think she wrote? Talk to your helper.



We are going to write a letter to the man in the moon. What are you going to write?

Think about what you would want to say to him.

In your book, write a letter to the man in the moon. Make sure you say your sentence out loud before you write it.

Use your sound mats to help your spellings and don't forget your finger spaces.



When you have finished, ask your helper to email a photo of your work so we can see what a fabulous job you have done!

Maths: Tens and ones

Let's do a warm up activity first. You will need 20 small objects e.g. lego bricks or buttons. Count out a group of ten objects and put them in a bowl. We are now going to make 17. Use the group of ten (keeping the objects in the bowl) and then count on from ten placing ones beside the bowl. When you reach 17 you should have your bowl of ten and 7 ones. 17 is made of 10 and 7. Now try making 19. Remember count on from your bowl of ten. Do you find it quicker than counting all of the objects?

Ten is made of 10 ones but once you know that you don't need to count out ten objects you can count / name the whole group as ten.

In your maths pack, you will find the worksheet 'tens and ones'. With your helper, read each instructions and complete the sheet carefully. Remember to count and check before moving onto the next question. Make sure that you form your numbers correctly. Keep your number line to hand to help you.
