

Think of your sentence.

Say your sentence out loud.

Write your sentence by sounding out each word or using your tricky words.

Make sure you leave a finger space between each word.



Maths: Two dice

Let's investigate. Roll two dice. Find the total number of dots on the top of the dice. Can you record this as an addition sum? For example $2 + 4 = 6$.

What other combinations of two numbers and totals can you find? Can you list them down? Can you find all of the combinations?

Want an extra challenge....How about using 3 dice? (or rolling 1 dice three times!)

Art: Decorate a fish

An active idea: Pirate ship

Your helper is the Pirate captain. When he /she says the instructions below you must follow them!

Scrub the Decks means that you kneel on your knees and pretend to scrub the floor.

Climb the Riggings means that you pretend to climb a rope ladder.

Captain's coming means that you salute and say "Aye Aye Captain".

Man aboard means that you put your hand above your eyes and look around.

Walk the plank means that you walk one foot in front of the other in a straight line.

Then you swap around and you can be the pirate captain! Have fun!


Collective Worship
