## Maths: Subtraction problems

Today we are going to solve problems using subtraction.

**Step 1** : Choose a problem to solve and stick it in your book.

**Step 2**: Carefully read the question.

**Step 3**: Find the important information.

In this example – there was 10 bottles and 3 smashed.

**Step 4**: Write the number sentence.

If I want to find out how many were left, I would need to find out

$$10 - 3 =$$

**Step 5**: Find the answer.

I could use a number line, I could use counters or I can use my number bonds to find the answer.

Now choose another problem.

In your maths pack, you will find 'Subtraction word problems'. With your helper, read each instructions and complete the sheet carefully. Remember to count and check before moving onto the next question. Make sure that you form your numbers correctly. Keep your number line to hand to help you.

I can make a picture using leaves and flowers and press it.




I can draw a map to show someone where some treasure is.
